## 2006 Training Solutions **FSB** Course Descriptions

The following course descriptions provide a brief overview of each course, along with the intended audience for the course topics. Please review carefully prior to enrollment in a course to ensure your training needs are met.

Course	Recommended Audience	Course Description
<b>FSBA System Administration</b> <i>Pre-requisite: none</i> <i>Required for FSBA System Administrator Certification</i>	Application Administrators who manage the runtime system. System Administrator Technical/IT personnel assigned to administer the system.	Introduction to the requirements for installation and administration of the production system. Managing files, workstation configuration, and setting runtime parameters are key topics. Attendees have the opportunity to become Certified System Administrators of the FSBA product.
<b>*S1 Authoring Toolkit Basics</b> <i>Pre-requisite: none</i>	Personnel responsible for customizing the FSBA product using the Authoring Toolkit.	Introduction to the authoring tools. Participants learn how to use the various components required for developing transactions, and retrieving and storing data, and other concepts for building and/or customizing an end-user interface.
<b>*S1 Custom Pascal</b> <i>Pre-requisite: S1 Authoring Toolkit Basics</i>	Personnel assigned to customize their FSBA system using authoring tools.	This course provides instruction on how to develop, register, and implement custom hooks using the ZEUS Pascal scripting language.
<b>*FSBA Custom Authoring</b> <i>Pre-requisite: Authoring Toolkit Basics, and Custom Pascal</i>	Personnel responsible for customizing the FSBA product using the Authoring Toolkit.	S1 provides consulting to facilitate working in a customer-specific dataset, along with providing training regarding management and delivery of authoring files. Customers provide an institution-specific project to work on, and apply their authoring toolkit knowledge.
<b>S1 Channel Server Administration</b> <i>Required for Channel Server System Administrator Certification</i>	Database Administrator who operates, maintains, and administers the Database Management System.	Management of the database, utilities, and applications related to the Channel Server environment, including the License Server. Full implementation of the S1 Channel Server and feature/functionality are included.
<b>S1 Marketing Center Administration and Marketing</b> <i>Required for Analytics System Administrator Certification</i>	Branch Operations, System Administrators, and Marketing personnel.	A comprehensive hands-on approach using the application to complete an end-to-end experience of the marketing lifecycle, including creating an offer, developing a message, and delivering the message to the financial institutions end customer.
<b>FSBA Migration Training Webinar</b> <i>Developed for ZFM to FSBA customers</i>	Bank personnel responsible for end user training, branch management, and System Administrators.	Three, two-hour sessions with demonstrations and discussions regarding functionality new to ZFM users migrating to the FSBA system. Two System Administrators need to attend all modules, and will have the opportunity to complete the requirements for System Administrator Certification.
<b>FSBA Migration Authoring Webinar</b> <i>Required for ZFM to FSBA customers with Authoring Tools</i>	Personnel responsible for customizing the FSBA product using the Authoring Toolkit.	Two three-hour sessions with demonstrations and discussions regarding authoring tool functionality new to ZFM users migrating to the FSBA system. PDF authoring, dialog customization, and object moving are the primary components of this training.
<b>FSBA Migration Authoring (West Hills location)</b> <i>Required for ZFM to FSBA customers with Authoring Tools</i>	Personnel responsible for customizing the FSBA product using the Authoring Toolkit.	This course provides demonstrations and discussions regarding authoring tool functionality new to ZFM users migrating to the FSBA system. This classroom environment provides hands-on experience with the product including PDF authoring, dialog customization, and object moving are the primary components of this training.
<b>FSBA Migration Training (West Hills location)</b> <i>Developed for ZFM to FSBA customers</i>	Bank personnel responsible for end user training, branch management, and System Administrators.	This course provides demonstrations and discussions regarding functionality new to ZFM users migrating to the FSBA system. This classroom environment provides hands-on experience with the product, including customization of the runtime system to accommodate institution-specific business processes using the runtime tools. Attendees will also complete the requirements for System Administrator Certification. Customers with authoring tools will also receive training on how to author in FSBA.
